Letter of agreement to extend the existing MoU

Cochrane Rehabilitation and the Croatian Society Of Physical And Rehabilitation Medicine mutually agree to continue to Memorandum of Understanding signed on 22/04/2018 till December 31st 2024.

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and among COCHRANE REHABILITATION, c/o IRCCS Fondazione Don Carlo Gnocchi, Milan – Italy (hereinafter referred to as “Cochrane Rehabilitation”) and the CROATIAN SOCIETY OF PHYSICAL AND REHABILITATION MEDICINE (hereinafter referred to as CMA) at Croatian Medical Association, Šubićeva 9, Zagreb, Croatia Hereinafter individually referred to as a “party” and collectively the “parties”.

Both parties agree that the points below substitute the corresponding points of the previous MoU:

2. Roles and responsibilities:

Pursuant to the terms of this MOU, each organisation commits to working together to undertake the following actions:

- The CMA can organize at their annual Congress at a regular basis a Cochrane Rehabilitation Session and/or Workshop, supported by Cochrane Rehabilitation but mainly driven by PRM physicians or allied health professionals of Croatian and neighbouring countries.
- Cochrane Rehabilitation will support the CMA to set up educational activities on evidence based medicine in PRM (in collaboration with the CR education committee).
- The CMA will support the dissemination of information, such as flyers and newsletters, and scientific activities among their members, including a "link" to the Cochrane Rehabilitation website inside the homepage, using social media if available (in collaboration with the CR communication committee).
- The CMA will be mentioned on the website of Cochrane Rehabilitation as a partner organisation, and vice versa
- The CMA will translate the Cochrane website, newsletter, materials in Turkish. This activity will be performed in collaboration with the Cochrane Rehabilitation Communication Committee.
- The CMA seeks to publish Cochrane corners in their National Journal (in collaboration with CR publication committee)
- Any other activity that fits the objective of the agreement on proposal of either of the parties and after agreement by both parties.



7. Duration of the MoU

This MOU will become effective from January 1st 2020 till December 31st 2024 – this MOU can be extended if mutually agreed by the parties.

10. Governing law and jurisdiction

Any dispute or disagreement shall preferably be resolved amicably by the parties. Exclusive place of jurisdiction shall be London; the laws of the United Kingdom shall be applicable. Except where expressly provided otherwise in this Agreement (including its schedules), in case of any dispute over the interpretation or the execution of this Agreement, the parties undertake to make every effort to settle their dispute by amicable agreement. If the parties are unable to settle a dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, the territorially competent court shall be that of the place where the plaintiff resides. The applicable law will be the national or state law of the plaintiff court.

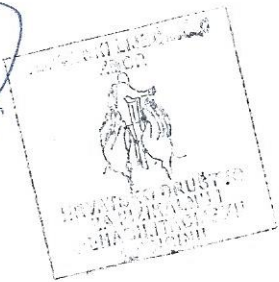
